And

Piramal Foundation - (for Program: Youth Volunteer- towards strengthening the youth ownership) situated at A56, Panchsheel Enclave, New Delhi - 110017, an institute that is rooted in the belief that, as a nation it is important to develop a cadre of leaders exposed to the complexities in the process of bringing change in social and public systems.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

1.5 Term of Agreement

- ❖ This Agreement, unless extended by mutual written consent of the Institute and the organization, shall expire in 1 year after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the Agreement shall be



extended for another 1 year by mutual consent.

4. Coordinators

❖ Both Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.

5. Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

❖ The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) that arise because of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the institute and organization.
