Naandi Foundation will conduct employability skills training programs for final-year female students enrolled in various courses at Rohtas Mahila College, Sasaram.



- The program shall be for a duration of 36 hours to 120 hours or as mutually decided by Naandi Foundation and the Institute.
- The program shall include New Age skills, Soft-Skills, Communication Skills, Life Skill and Interview The program situation Skills, Life S preparation for the beneficiaries under the employability skill development program.
- Beneficiaries will be students of final year courses of Under Graduate and Post Graduate programme at the institution.
- The Institute will ensure that necessary infrastructure such as well-equipped classrooms and computer The Institute such as well-equilable as per course requirements is available at the program's location.
- 6. The institute will ensure that basic training requirements like black/white board, chalk/markers, A4 sheets, projector and screen are available during the training.
- The institute will ensure to identify a resource person (henceforth referred to as POC Point of Contact) from their faculty group to coordinate between the beneficiary, institute management and Naandi Foundation.
- Institutes should ensure that all beneficiaries are given an orientation on the importance and facilitation of joining employment skills training programs prior to training and encourage them to register for the said programs.
- The POC will monitor trainee attendance daily and ensure 70% attendance.
- 10. The Institute will share placement details of MPC trained students with Naandi staff as per requirement.
- 11. Naandi Foundation will impart employability skill training to socially and economically disadvantaged students and youth, helping to improve their livelihoods and economic security.
- 12. Naandi Foundation will prepare content that will be most effective in training the beneficiaries/students.
- 13. Naandi Foundation will share a detailed Course Schedule and Framework
- 14. Naandi Foundation ensure that well-trained trainers are identified and deployed to ensure overall success of the Program.
- 15. Naandi Foundation will monitor the program by conducting periodic assessments for the students.
- 16. Naandi Foundation shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the beneficiaries for the Employability Skill Training Program as it is a part of Mahindra and Mahindra CSR initiative.
- 17. Students will be certified by Naandi Foundation upon successful completion of the training, with attendance above 70% and passing all assessments.
- 18. This Collaboration Letter shall be governed by laws of India and shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts situated at Rohtas.
